Subject: **POLICY AND OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES FOR LOCAL PURCHASE OF MEDICINES (DAY TO DAY).**

Please refer to unified Health Department's letter No. SO (P-I) H/3-64/2008 dated 12.09.2013 on the subject noted above.


2. The following policy and operational guidelines for local purchase of medicines (Day to Day) is hereby re-notified for your guidance and strict compliance:

- i. Local Purchase in Government Hospitals is allowed to ensure fulfillment of immediate need of medical treatment that is otherwise not possible from medicines and surgical disposables available with hospital. Local Purchase is permitted for emergencies and indoor patients department on the prescription of authorized medical practitioner. Currently, 15% of the total budget of medicine is earmarked in hospitals for local purchase system. Detail is at Flag-A.
- ii. Local purchase costs government higher price in comparison to bulk purchases. Therefore, the aim is to reduce the incidences of local purchase by identifying commonly and frequently purchased items and including them into the list of bulk purchase mandate. The non-availability of prescribed medicines or its alternates within the hospital generates justification of local purchase, therefore, the policy requires hospitals to establish non-availability of prescribed medicine through an authorized Pharmacist/ Consultant/ Medical Superintendents on case to case basis to avoid duplication of expenditure of available resources.
- iii. The complete consolidated record including medicine name and its quantities purchased during (previous) financial year would be recorded and made available to bidders as "Reference Trend List" so that they may estimate the frequency of purchases of the hospital. This trend list will be used by bidders as basis to estimate magnitude of local purchases for offering maximum discounts in tenders.

- iv. In order to ensure transparency, a local online purchase portal has been designed with following features and requirements:
- a) Total Allocated Budget for Medicines for Local Purchase-Budget Consumed and Budget remaining.
  - b) A password and login will be issued to Incharge Pharmacist/ Medical Superintendent/ Consultant for data Entry in Local Purchase portal and locally purchased items will be posted in portal on daily basis.
  - c) Purchase order may be emailed to the L.P supplier through L.P portal. Contractor will submit invoice/bill with supply on daily basis.
  - d) Supply will be received through Incharge Hospital Pharmacist/ Medical Superintendent/ Consultant with same brand that was mentioned in the purchase order with batch and expiry which will be mentioned in GRN (Goods Receipt Note).
  - e) The maximum limit of Local Purchase per day will be One Million, however, the software is capable of allowing further purchase subject to generating alert for admn and reasons to be recorded in writing.
  - f) Local purchase may be of two types (i) Bulk Local purchase (ii) specific Patient Local purchase that will be dispensed through system.
  - g) Profile of vendor should be filled/ uploaded on Local Purchase online system (Local Purchase Portal) with Drug Sales License. The contractor will be bound to provide the source of his purchase as and when required.
- v. It is established policy of the government to enter into local purchase contracts through open competitive tendering. The policy emphasis hospitals to use the purchase committee in local purchase tenders, its scrutiny, sanctioning, placement of order, receiving, defacing and issuance of medicines, record keeping and payment process. The Medical Superintendent of hospital shall be responsible for having all these arrangements in place.
- vi. Contract may be signed with pharmacy license holder on form No. 9 through tender advertisement and as per Punjab Procurement Rules 2014. Local Purchase Contractor shall supply all the medicines as per Drugs act 1976/ DRAP Act, 2012 and rules framed thereunder.
- vii. Discount will be calculated on Maximum Retail Price fixed by the Drug Regulatory Authority of Pakistan (DRAP).
- viii. The Tender should be awarded to the contractor as per Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014 offering maximum discount on following categories:
- i. For Multinational manufacturers. (Medicines)
  - ii. For Local Manufacturers. (Medicines)

- iii. For Surgical/Disposable items.
- ix. A formulary has been designed by the Drugs Control Wing of Primary & Secondary Healthcare Department with all details of approved brands mentioned against each generic. (**Flag-B**) The rationale for including these brands is the trusted quality through repeated analysis by the Drugs Testing Laboratories of Punjab. In case any health facility prefers to procure medicine of brands other than mentioned in formulary as attached at Flag-B, the Medical Superintendent/ Incharge of such health facility shall ensure that the medicine brand supplied for the first time (after this notification) are sent to respective Drugs Testing laboratory. The drugs samples, so sent, shall comply with all SOPs and requirements of testing as notified from time to time and shall be in appropriate quantity as well as in four distinct portions. Moreover, any payment in respect of these items (outside formulary) shall be made after clearance of Drugs sample from Drugs Testing Laboratories.
- x. Maximum effort should be put in to procure the brand prescribed in the formulary against each generic.
- xi. It must be ensured that same brand should be received in stock or receiving whose invoice/bill is submitted.
- xii. (Generics) Item Code will be allocated to Central Drug Formulary that will start From Sr. No 1 and up to 400 for generics of drugs on Local Purchase Portal. Drugs/items other than central drugs formulary will be issued from coding that starts from sr.No.401 to onwards. For Brands of same generic the coding will be as: i.e. Generic item code is 1(For 1-5 different brands against that generic the coding may be as (1-1,1-2,1-3,1-4,1-5....).
- xiii. Local purchase may be within prescribed limit of 15% of the total budget of medicines.
- xiv. Repeated items that are being purchased through L.P may be identified and communicated to Procurement Cell for procurement through bulk purchase.
- xv. For items being repeatedly purchased locally may be procure through Rule No. 59-B of Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014.
- xvi. A Focal Person/Pharmacist will be designated by the M.S of each hospital for communication with Procurement Cell, P&SHD & Contractor.
- xvii. A monthly meeting may be conducted at department's level where analysis of monthly Local Purchase of each Health Facility will be discussed with Medical Superintendent and Incharge Pharmacist of each Health Facility. Two officers (M.S & Incharge Pharmacist) from DHQ and two officers from THQ will be selected on monthly basis for managing Local Purchase in best way and will be awarded with appreciation letters/certificates.

- xviii. Local purchase will be initiated with the orders of Consultants/Senior Medical Officers only via prescription that will be maintained as record of Local Purchase and it will not be for more than 7 days for one patient.
- xix. In case of non-supply of any item within stipulated time period as per contract, risk purchase may be done from any other reputable pharmacy and difference shall be deducted from the performance guarantee of contractor.
- xx. A monthly report will be prepared by Incharge Pharmacist and will be discussed in Pharmacy & Therapeutic Committee and the minutes will be communicated to Procurement Cell on each month up to 5th of every month with improvement and corrective measure by the members of P&TC.
- xxi. Disasters and emergencies have different set of rules and SOPs and these can be handled as per provision of emergency as defined under Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014.
